


Models for projections on unstable surfaces and bodies.

From painted, torn and remodulated cartons I have built a model. Prepared particles and particles from the space around were projected back onto the model and into the space of where they come from. The cardboard model forms the stage for the particles of the space. The projected point drawings are geometric models that are perforated into aluminum foil. They are derived from fixed points around.

Tinfoil, transparent film, dust, hair, various particles of unknown and known origin, permanent marker, ink, polystyrene, turpentine, cardboard, paint, glass.
